Strategies for Conflict Resolution Among Middle School ...

Conflict is inevitable among communities, including in schools. It's easy enough for adults to solve kids' conflicts. "Lena, I saw you take Josie's ball. Give it back and say you're sorry." This type of adult intervention doesn't empower students to solve their own conflicts. Conflict resolution is a learned skill; it takes practice.

Ten Strategies for Conflict Resolution • When angry, separate yourself from the situation and take time to cool out. • Attack the problem, not the person. Start with a compliment. • Communicate your feelings assertively, NOT aggressively. Express them without blaming. • Focus on the issue, NOT your position about the issue.

Kenneth Thomas and Ralph Kilmann developed five conflict resolution strategies that people use to handle conflict, including avoiding, defeating, compromising, accommodating, and collaborating. This is based on the assumption that people choose how cooperative and how assertive to be in a conflict.
