ACTIVITY ANALYSIS . Activities are composed of many skills that can be divided for the purposes of analysis into: • Physical • Cognitive • Psychological • Interpersonal . In order to understand the effect an activity will have on the client, the therapist needs to break it down into these skill areas and look at each one in detail.

The use of activity analysis in occupational therapy daily practice was examined by survey. One hundred occupational therapists who serve as fieldwork educators received survey forms with thirty seven usable question naires being returned. The study found that all therapists were doing activity analysis as a mental process; however,
